AN ORDER ACCEPTING THE REPORT SUBMITTED BY THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR THE PERIOD March 1, 2018 THRU March 31, 2018

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF WALKER COUNTY TEXAS, that:


WHEREAS, LGC §114.026(a) requires that the County Treasurer at least once at month at a regular term of the commissioner court make a detailed report of (1) money received and disbursed, (2) debts due and owed by the county, and (3) all other proceedings in the treasurer's office.

WHEREAS, LGC §114.026(c) requires that 'after the commissioners court has compared and examined the treasurer's report and has determined the report is correct, the court shall enter an order in its minutes approving the report'.


WHEREAS, LGC §114.026(d) requires that 'before the adjournment of a regular term of the commissioners court, the county judge and each county commissioner shall give an affidavit stating that the requirement of subsection (c) have been met at that term'.

WHEREAS, In accordance with Local Government Code §114.026, the County Treasurer has submitted a report that details money received and disbursed. The report submitted by County Treasurer states that \$_100.00__ are on hand in the office of the county treasurer for the report period that is not in the county investment accounts or county depository. The amount reported by the County Treasurer by fund of the cash received for the report period is attached as Exhibit A. The amount reported by the County Treasurer by fund of the cash disbursements for the report period is attached as Exhibit B. The debt schedule at the end of the period is Exhibit C. A summary of all transactions in bank and investments is Exhibit D.







RESOLUTION 2018-61

"Hazard Mitigation Plan for Walker County and the City of New Waverly and the City of Riverside"

- WHEREAS,** Certain areas of Walker County are subject to periodic flooding and other natural hazards with the potential to cause damage to people's properties within the area; and
- WHEREAS,** Walker County desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and
- WHEREAS,** Under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and
- WHEREAS,** Walker County and the City of New Waverly and the City of Riverside, in order to meet this requirement, have initiated development of a local Hazard Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Walker County hereby:

Adopts the Walker County Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Vests the Emergency Management Coordinator with the responsibility, authority, and the means to:

- (a) Inform all concerned parties of this action.
- (b) Develop an addendum to this Hazard Mitigation Plan if the county's unique situation warrants such an addendum.

Appoints the Emergency Management Coordinator to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to Walker County's addendum to the Hazard Mitigation Plan be developed and presented to the Walker County Commissioners' Court for consideration.

Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
