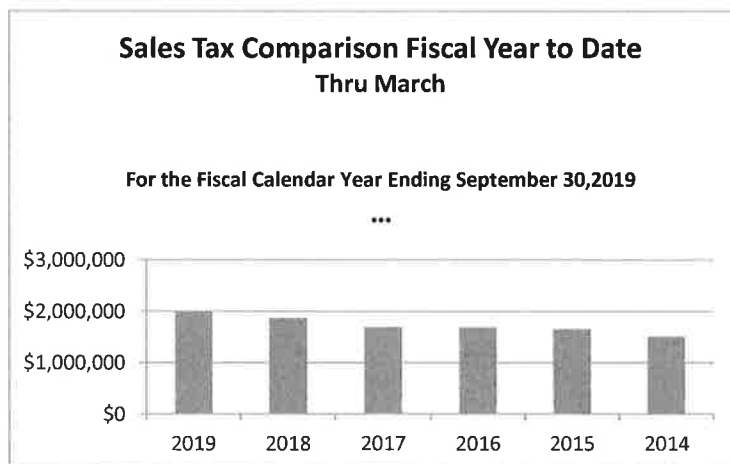

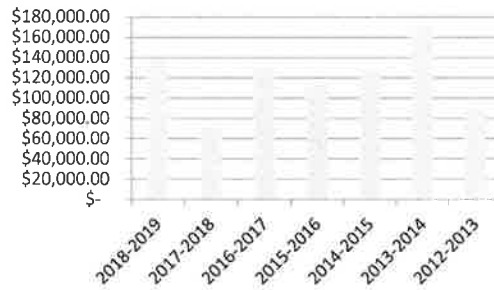

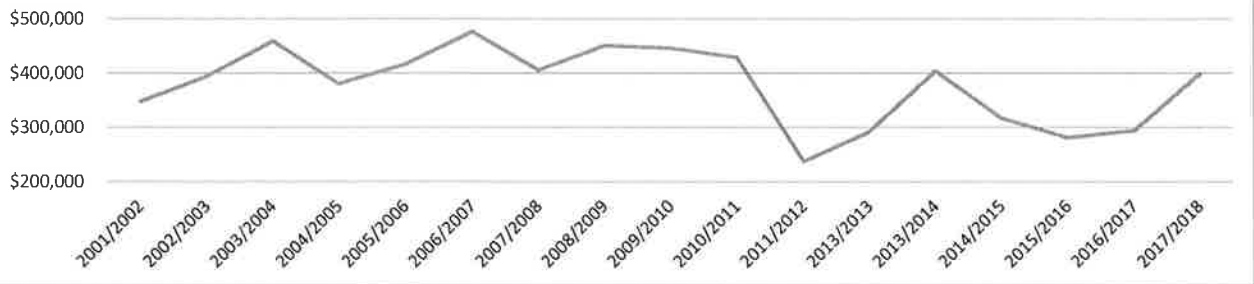
Revenue Comparison Thru February
