Weigh Station Revenue Comparison by Fiscal Year





Legacy Roads Improvement Program

A method for upgrading the condition and status of a private road in Walker County

Summary and Purpose:

Prior to the adoption of the first Subdivision Policy by Walker County in 1999 it was not uncommon for developers to subdivide properties and create subdivisions that included roads that were not built to any sort of county standard. These developments have long suffered from a decision made over 20 years ago and their only current recourse is to upgrade the road at their expense to current county standards and then ask the Commissioners Court to accept them for maintenance.

Access by residents, mail carriers, school busses, and emergency personnel, is either not possible, or is highly difficult during rainy periods. The deep potholes are a danger **to** low riding vehicles, such as small cars. Property owners in these areas are residents of Walker County and pay their fair share of property taxes while receiving reduced benefits compared to those fortunate enough to reside on a county-maintained road.

The proposed program is made possible by the Texas Transportation Code, Title 6, Subtitle C, Chapter 253 (Code). It creates a method whereby residents of platted subdivisions with roads currently not maintained by the county to have a pathway to have their roads improved to a better, safer, condition. The verbiage from that Code is included as a part of this document.

By creating the Legacy Road Improvement Program, the Commissioners Court will put into place processes, rules and regulations that clearly define actions necessary to upgrade roads and improve the quality of life for Walker County residents.

Sec. 253.003. PROPOSAL FOR COUNTY IMPROVEMENT OF SUBDIVISION ROADS AND ASSESSMENT OF COSTS. If the commissioners court of a county determines that the improvement of a road in a subdivision or of an access road to a subdivision is necessary for the public health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the county, the commissioners court may propose to:

(1) improve the road to comply with county standards for roads; and

(2) assess all or part of the costs of the improvement pro rata against the record owners of the real property of the subdivision or a defined part of the subdivision.

 - (c) If the proposition fails, the commissioners court may not:
 - (1) order the improvement and assessment; or
- (2) again propose the improvement and assessment before the fourth anniversary of the date the county clerk declares the results of the vote to the commissioners court.

Proposed Process:

- 1. The requestors must deliver to the County Clerk a petition from 25% of the property owners in the affected area requesting an election on the road being improved and accepted by the County be called by Commissioners Court. The petition must:
 - a. Describe the project in detail. This description must be an agreed upon project scope authored by the residents and reviewed by the appropriate county commissioner.
 - b. Certify with evidence that the road(s) described was created in placed into service prior to December 1, 2000.
 - c. The type of improvements being requested.
 - d. The total cost of the entire project.
 - e. The cost to each resident within the affected area.
 - f. Clearly state that the costs shall be assessed against the affected properties and added to their tax bill.
 - g. The approximate annual cost, and the length of the payback term.
 - h. That a lien will be placed on each affected property until the assessment is repaid.
- 2. Once the petition is accepted by the County Clerk, the requestor must have the item placed on the Commissioners Court agenda for discussion by the Court.
- 3. The Commissioners Court shall review the petition and take action based on the discussion. The actions may include but are not limited to:
 - a. Vote to accept the petition and begin the Legacy Road Improvement program for the area described in the petition.
 - b. Table the item for a future court discussion
 - c. Vote to accept the petition, but decline to authorize the road project.
 - d. Decline to take action, effectively terminating the process
- 4. If the petition is accepted by the Court and the program is authorized to proceed the requestor must deliver to the Court the following documents and information prior to the Court calling for the election:
 - a. A listing of all the current property owners and their mailing addresses. The list will be verified by the County and used to mail out the election materials.
 - b. A listing of all property owners abutting the existing road(s) and a notarized document from each stating their agreement to provide the necessary easements to the County for the section of road across their property. The document must state that the owner understands that there will be no compensation provided for the easement, and that the property lines are not being altered.
 - i. The project shall not proceed until easement statements for the entire length of the proposed project road have been received.

- ii. Official easement documents will be authored for each property after all required actions are complete, the election is called, and the project is approved by the residents.
- 5. The Commissioners Court shall proceed with the processes described in Section 25.003 of the Code. This includes scheduling public hearings, public notice, and a mailed ballot to affected land owners.
 - a. Once returned to the Court, the ballots shall be counted and the totals recorded.
 - b. Commissioners shall vote on whether or not to proceed with the project.
 - c. Funding sources shall be discussed, and it is possible that a project may be approved but not completed due to lack of funding.
- 6. If the Improvement project is approved, the Court shall direct the requestor to obtain official easements from each of the property owners affected by the road improvement project. Once all easements have been received and recorded the County shall contact the Tax Appraiser and establish the assessment process for each affected property.
- 7. Only after all the above described actions have been satisfactorily completed shall the County commence any work or accrue any expenses associated with the improvement project.
