Job related details and responsibilities on following page

The following is details and responsibilities of the Jail Mechanic position along with other duties as assigned.

Types of work to be performed:

- A/C- replace evaporators, condensers, compressors, TXV/Oriface tubes, evacuate/charge/reclaim refrigerant
- Electrical
- Service Transmissions
- Brakes
- Wheel bearing Hubs (front)
- Motor mounts
- Tire Repairs
- Balance tires
- Repair exhaust leaks
- PERFORM FULL SERVICE regularly

Full service details

- Change oil and filter
- Fill windshield washer fluid reservoir
- Rotate and balance tires
- Check tire air pressure
- Check for foreign objects in tires (nails, screws, wire)
- Check brakes "And brake fluid
- Check front wheel bearing hubs and tie rods
- Check rear differential grease
- Check and lube any grease fittings
- Check belts and hoses • Check power steering fluid

- Check transmission fluid
- Check for coolant /oil leaks
- Clean and /or replace air filter
- Check lights, blinkers, reverse lights, side markers, License plate lights

Service East Tower Generator

Start once a week

- Check oil, coolant, and fuel levels
- Run under load
- Change oil/ oil filter, fuel filter

Equipment

- Lift and jacks, jack stands
- Tire machine
- Wheel balancer
- A/C recovery, recycling, recharging machine
- Use a Trouble code reader

Certifications

- MAC- Mobile Air Conditioning (required to operate A/C recycling recovery machine)
- ASE certifications (preferred)
- TCOLE Jailers License required within 1 year
