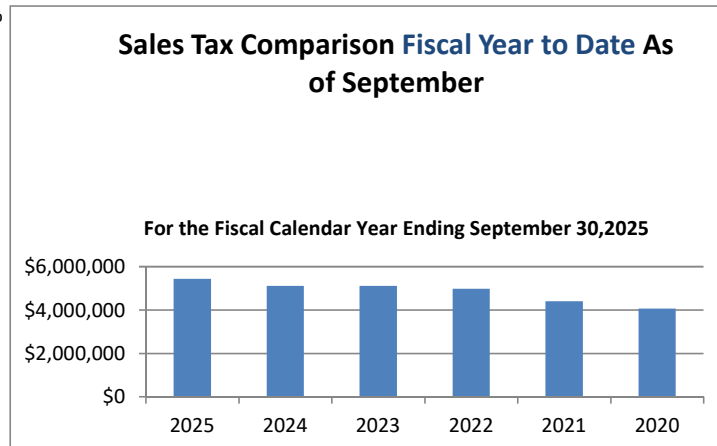

Weigh Station Revenue Comparison by Fiscal Year

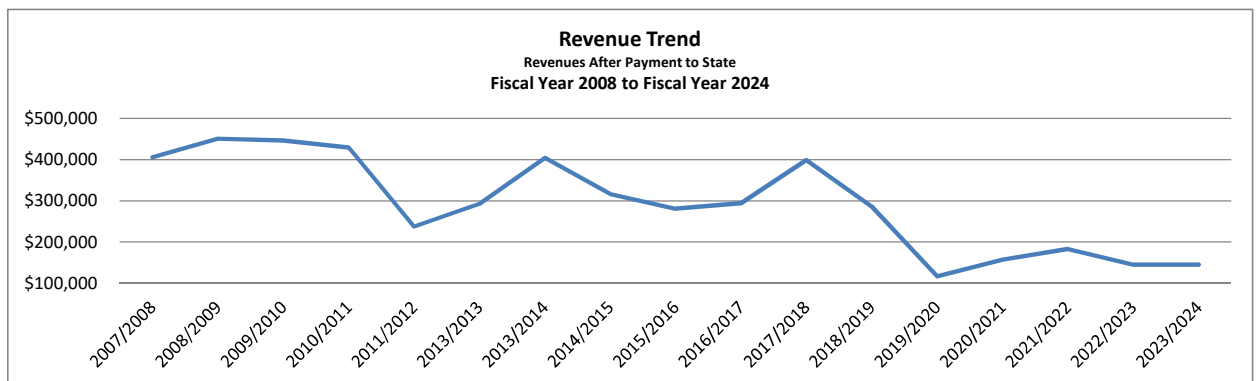
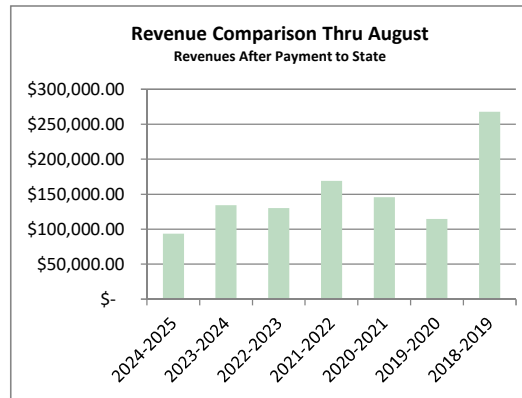
