**ORDER OF THE COUNTY JUDGE  
ESTABLISHING CURFEW**

Pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, a curfew is hereby established for all areas of Walker County, Texas from 11:59 pm until 5:00 am each day to go into effect on Monday, March 23, 2020. All individuals shall remain in or on personal property and avoid traveling on any public road or highway during this period of curfew. Individuals who are traveling to or from a place of employment, assisting with emergency operations at the request of the Emergency Management Coordinator or his designee, traveling through Walker County, Texas, or otherwise unable to comply due to an emergency necessity are exempt from the requirements of this order. This order shall also not apply to a licensed food establishment providing food and other consumables to others, a facility approved by the County Judge providing food and other consumables as part of the pandemic relief effort, or individuals who are travelling to and from a licensed food establishment or approved disaster relief facility to obtain food or other consumables and any other establishments that provides food and other emergency relief supplies.

A person who violates this order is subject to a \$1,000.00 fine and/ or 180 days confinement in the Walker County Jail.

As County Judge, I hereby deem it necessary and so order that the curfew is hereby ordered until further notice or is rescinded.
