Mobile testing site 5/4/20: 4 positives out of 149 tested, all 4 are re-tests, not new cases / 127 were Walker County residents

Mobile test site 5/10/20: 9 positives out of 171 tested with 1 pending, 7 were re-test and 2 were new cases / 153 were Walker County residents

Mobile test site 5/20/20 CANCELED by the State at this time. Beginning Monday, May 18, 2020, Texas Military Department will begin focusing their efforts on testing nursing homes, assisted living facilities and long-term care facilities.
