Tests performed and reported to OEM: 3961 (includes mobile test sites below)

Mobile Test Sites

- June 9, 2020 – tested 118 individuals
- June 10, 2020 – tested 74 individuals
- June 11, 2020 – tested 77 individuals
- June 24, 2020 – tested 268 individuals
- June 25, 2020 – tested 292 individuals

Next community testing is July 8, July 22, & July 23, 2020, 9am-6pm at the Walker County Fairgrounds. Symptoms do not have to be present to test, however, you must register at www.txcovidtest.org or call 512-883-2400, valid ID is required at test site. Registration begins 24 hours prior.
