**TESTING**

Tests performed and reported to OEM: 7444 (includes mobile test sites below)

**Mobile Test Sites:**

- June 9, 2020 – tested 118 individuals
- June 10, 2020 – tested 74 individuals
- June 11, 2020 – tested 77 individuals
- June 24, 2020 – tested 268 individuals (not all Walker County residents)
- June 25, 2020 – tested 292 individuals (not all Walker County residents)
- July 8, 2020 – tested 278 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 22, 2020 – tested 217 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 23, 2020 – tested 236 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 29, 2020 – tested 227 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 30, 2020 – tested 180 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 4, 2020 – tested 271 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 11, 2020 – tested 246 (not all Walker County residents)

Next community testing dates are August 15, August 18 & August 25, 8am-4pm at the Walker County Fairgrounds. Symptoms do not have to be present to test, registration will be performed on-site, valid ID is required at test site.
