Tests performed and reported to OEM: 7799 (includes mobile test sites below)

- June 24, 2020 – tested 268 individuals (not all Walker County residents)
- June 25, 2020 – tested 292 individuals (not all Walker County residents)
- July 8, 2020 – tested 278 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 22, 2020 – tested 217 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 23, 2020 – tested 236 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 29, 2020 – tested 227 (not all Walker County residents)
- July 30, 2020 – tested 180 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 4, 2020 – tested 271 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 11, 2020 – tested 246 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 15, 2020 – tested 129 (not all Walker County residents)
- August 18, 2020 – tested 127 (not all Walker County resident)
