Due to the percentage hospitalized COVID patients in Trauma Service Area Q, Walker County business must follow the Roll-Back in Executive Order GA-32 as below:

Immediately upon signing on Thursday, January 7, 2021, unless amended or rescinded, the following is in effect:

2. Bars or similar establishments must cease all on-premises services. The use by bars or similar establishments of drive-thru, pickup, or delivery options for food and drinks remains allowed to the extent authorized by TABC.
