**Due to the percentage hospitalized COVID patients in Trauma Service Area Q, Walker County business must follow the Roll-Back in Executive Order GA-32 as below:**

Immediately upon signing on Thursday, January 7, 2021, unless amended or rescinded, the following is in effect:

1. Any business establishment that otherwise would have a 75 percent occupancy or operating limit may operate at up to only 50 percent of the total listed occupancy of the establishment.
2. Bars or similar establishments must cease all on-premises services. The use by bars or similar establishments of drive-thru, pickup, or delivery options for food and drinks remains allowed to the extent authorized by TABC.
