COVID-19 Vaccines

Huntsville, Walker County— Saturday, March 20, 2021 —

As we receive COVID-19 vaccine allocations, Huntsville Family Medicine and Huntsville Memorial Hospital in partnership with the Walker County Office of Emergency Management, will be providing COVID-19 vaccinations based on the [current phase \(s\)](#) published by the Texas Department of State Health Services.

Currently, we are scheduling appointments to receive the Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) COVID-19 vaccine for the following individuals:

- **Phase 1A:** Health Care Workers – Hospital, Long-term care, EMS 9-1-1, Home Health, Outpatient, ER/Urgent Care, Pharmacies, Last Responders, School Nurses
- **Phase 1A:** Residents of Long-Term Care Facilities
- **Phase 1B:** Persons 65 and older
- **Phase 1B:** Persons 18 and older with at least one chronic medical condition, including pregnancy
- **Phase 1C:** Persons 50 to 64 years of age
- School and Child Care Personnel

PLEASE NOTE: There are a very limited number of COVID-19 vaccine appointments available. You will be answering a series of questions to determine if you are eligible for the vaccine, but eligibility does not guarantee that you will receive a vaccine appointment. We will be working over the coming weeks to ramp up the number of available appointments. Thank you for your patience.
