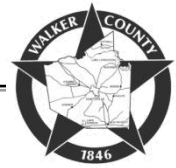

DEFENSIVE DRIVING APPLICATION (MANDATORY)

You may be able to require that this charge be dismissed by entering a plea of no contest or guilty and successfully complete a Driver Safety Course (DSC) or Motorcycle Operator Training Course (MOTC). You will lose the right if, on or before your appearance date you fail to provide the Court with notice of your request to take the course.

If you desire to complete a driver safety course under Article 45.0511 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, ***you must not have completed a driver safety course within the 12 months preceding the date of your citation; you must not be the holder of a commercial drivers license (CDL); you must not have exceeded the speed limit by 25 mph or above in a regular traffic zone and you must provide the following to the Court:***

- _____ a. A photocopy of your current auto liability policy
- _____ b. A photocopy of your valid Texas Drivers License ** (MILITARY EXEMPTION: Active military, their spouses & dependents)
- _____ c. A photocopy of this completed and signed DSC application

MANDATORY DSC/MOTC FEES: \$145.00 – DUE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE COURT GRANTING YOUR REQUEST

The Court will review your application and supporting documents and the judge's decision and/or terms and conditions of defensive driving will be mailed to you at the address you provide. Please complete and sign below.
